**A film by Ginette Laurin and Oana Suteu
WIRE FRAME
NOMINATED AT THE ROSE D'OR FESTIVAL**

Montreal, February 14, 2006 – Nominations announced by the Rose D'Or Festival include the film *Wire Frame*, a production of **Amérimage-Spectra** based on an original concept by **Ginette Laurin** and **Oana Suteu**. The film has been nominated in the Arts & Specials category along with 16 other productions from around the world. The Rose D'Or Festival, with 140 companies from some 30 countries participating, ranks among the most important of those devoted to worldwide television programming. Created in 1961, its aim is to honor excellence in the area of television variety programs. In recent years, a number of Amérimage-Spectra productions have been nominated and/or won a prize at this prestigious festival.¹

An adaptation for TV of the work *Passare* (2004) by Montreal dance company **O Vertigo**, *Wire Frame* explores a confrontation between art and life. To exquisite music by **Peter Scherer**, the film portrays two days in the life of an architect faced with a critical situation. As we are introduced to his inner universe, we become privy to his creative process at a point where, while suffering through a breakup in a relationship, he is attempting to revise the design for a building.

Production of this film was made possible thanks to the support of the **Canadian Television Fund (CTF)** created by the Government of Canada and the Canadian cable industry; **CTF: License Fee Program**; Quebec's **Tax Credit for Cinema and Television: Gestion SODEC**; the **Canadian Film or Video Production Tax Credit**; and with the collaboration of **Bravo, ARTV, and TFO**.

Wire Frame was co-written and directed by **Oana Suteu**, while **Ginette Laurin** co-wrote and was responsible for choreography. The film was produced by **Pierre L. Touchette**, president of Amérimage-Spectra, and **Alain Simard**, president of L'Équipe Spectra. Executive producer is **Luc Châtelain**, vice-president of L'Équipe Spectra's film and television division. *Wire Frame* is one of a number of films on dance made by Amérimage-Spectra. It aired on TFO and Bravo last December and will be presented on **ARTV** in the upcoming months.
