**Back in Montreal after its huge success in 2003 and 2004**  
**Second show added for the Glenn Miller Orchestra!**  
**With pianist virtuoso Richard Abel as special guest**

**Montreal, Thursday June 29** – Due to huge ticket sales for the **Glenn Miller Orchestra** concert event on August 29<sup>th</sup> at **Théâtre St-Denis**, **L'Équipe Spectra** and **Didier Morissonneau** announce the addition of a **second show on August 30<sup>th</sup>**. To accommodate these changes, the Orchestra's Quebec City and Halifax dates were moved up a day. Didier Morissonneau has produced this spectacular swing orchestra across Canada for 15 years, with Montreal always one of their most enthusiastic markets. And now more than ever! Not since 1994 has the Glenn Miller Orchestra performed back to back shows in this city, although in 2004 they filled Salle Wilfrid-Pelletier to the breaking point, as always with **Richard Abel** as their special guest.

With its unique jazz sound, the Glenn Miller Orchestra is considered to be one of the greatest bands of all time, bringing timeless classics like ***In the Mood, Moonlight Serenade, Chattanooga Choo Choo, Pennsylvania 6-5000, String of Pearls*** and ***Tuxedo Junction*** back to the stage. The world famous Glenn Miller Orchestra is the most popular and sought after big band in the world today, playing an average of 300 live dates a year. 20 musicians and singers will bring the unforgettable Glenn Miller sound to the St-Denis. Performing under the musical direction of famous trombonist Larry O'Brien, the Glenn Miller Orchestra delivers an evening of jazz, swing, timeless classics and traditional big band numbers.

Richard Abel is one of Canada's most popular pianists, whose 24-year career has given a large audience to instrumental music, be it classical or popular. Richard Abel has release 13 albums with his most recent being *Eleganca* and has sold over one million records in Canada alone. Three of his records have gone Gold; two, Platinum; and Richard Abel has been nominated two times for a Juno Award as "Best Instrumental Album", in 2002 and 2003 for his album *Romance*.

Inspired by the amazing Liberace, Richard Abel displays his spectacular showmanship and dexterity. He takes us through a musical wonderland with surprises, stories and laughter creating an entertainment adventure. His perseverance and outstanding talent have taken him onto the greatest stages around the world.
